Commission (Staff) release public benefit ratios

Jan 2018

Comment: Staff's independent assessment and scoring

Appeals due for public benefit ratios (PBRs)

Jan/Feb 2018

Comments:

- Appeals process is limited to PBRs (CCR 6008)
- 3 weeks for applicant to submit a letter of appeal (CCR 6008(a)(1)) with a maximum 20-page response.
- 3 weeks for Commission staff to respond (CCR 6008(a)(3))

Commission determines final public benefit ratios March 2018

Commission finalizes component scores and ranks projects April/May 2018

Commission releases maximum conditional eligibility determinations and early funding decisions for completing environmental documentation and permits

May/June 2018

Comments:

- Maximum conditional eligibility determination is the "not to exceed" funding amount per project (CCR 6011(a))
- Commission can adjust component scores within limits (CCR 6011(b))
- Commission & public have 30 days to review component scores before Water Commission can meet (CCR 6011(a))
- Ranking can be provided 10 days in advance of Water Commission meeting (CCR 6011(g))
