MINUTES

ROLL CALL

Roll was called (see Attachment A), which resulted in 16 eligible representatives. This equated to 68% of the current participation percentage being in attendance, which is greater than the 50% need to have a quorum of the Reservoir Committee. By 1:30 p.m., two additional members joined, bringing the participation percentage to 79.9%.

CALL TO ORDER

Acting Chair Traynham called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA APPROVAL

It was moved by Hartwig and seconded by Kunde to approve the October 18, 2018 Agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

INTRODUCTIONS

The Sites Reservoir Committee members, staff and members of the public introduced themselves.

MINUTES APPROVAL

It was moved by Kunde and seconded by Brittian to approve the September 21, 2018 Reservoir Committee Minutes, as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

PERIOD OF PUBLIC COMMENT

Director Traynham called for public comment. Hearing none, she closed the period of public comment.

3.2 Consider approval of the Reservoir Committee's portion of the Payment of Claims (*Attachments 3-2A, B & C*)

<u>Action</u>: It was moved by Murphy and seconded by Cheng to approve the Reservoir Committee's portion of the Payment of Claims, as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

3.3 Discussion and possible direction to staff regarding proposed changes to the Phase 2 work plan, which will also affect technical effort, associated near-term funding, and the requirements in the proposed Phase 2 Reservoir Project Agreement (*Presentation*). And, as a result of the decision to evaluate an alternative near-term approach, consider a 1-month time extension to the completion of Phase 1 from February 28 through March 31, 2018 to implement a revised strategy for Phase 2 (i.e. 2019 through 2021).

General Manager Watson made a presentation regarding proposed changes to the Phase 2 work plan, which would affect technical effort, associated near-term funding and the requirements in the proposed Phase 2 Reservoir Project Agreement. He stated that dependent upon todays decision, a 1-month time extension to the completion of Phase 1 from February 28 to March 31, 2018 to implement a revised strategy for Phase 2 is recommended.

A lengthy discussion followed regarding comparisons between Plans A through D, costs, WIIN Act milestones, impacts to project, cash call vs financing, permits, participation, Federal Feasibility Report and rebalancing. A decision to poll the Committee members present to which Plan they would be willing to support was taken and whether they would finance or do a cash call, with the majority supporting Plan C as the ceiling budget and to pursue a cash call for 2019.

General Manager Watson stated he would work with Mr. Brown regarding revised participation agreements and with Mr. Montague on cancelling the Bank Credit Facility RFP and return in November with revised work plan and budget for Phase 2.

Action: It was moved by Davis and seconded by Marks to recommend approval of a 1month time extension to the completion of Phase 1 from February 28 to March 31, 2018 to implement a revised strategy for Phase 2 (i.e. 2019 through 2021). Motion carried unanimously.
