## **MINUTES**

## **ROLL CALL:**

Roll was called (see Attachment A), which resulted in 19 eligible representatives. This equated to 78.1% of the current participation percentage being in attendance, which is greater than the 50% needed to have a quorum of the Reservoir Committee. By 1:15 p.m. two additional members were seated, bringing the total to 84.7%.

## **INTRODUCTIONS:**

The Sites Reservoir Committee members, staff and members of the public introduced themselves.

#### **CALL TO ORDER:**

Vice-chair Headrick called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **AGENDA APPROVAL:**

Mr. Michael Hurley from California Water Service stated he'd requested clarification at the December 20, 2018 Reservoir Committee Meeting regarding the reimbursement of funds once a participant has withdrawn from the project. He also stated he was told it would be placed on the Reservoir's Agenda for discussion and that had not happened. He requested that this matter be resolved. Discussion followed, with direction given to the General Manager.

No further comment being heard, Vice-chair Headrick closed the period of public comment.

1.1 Introductory remarks.

Mr. Azevedo stated Prop 1 recognizes local flood benefits and the Sites Project area experienced 5" of rain in 48 hours which resulted in I-5 being closed for 12.5 hours. He stated further he interacted with traffic on I-5 that was regional flood not just local and should Sites have been in place, the closure of I-5 would not have happened.

General Manager Watson stated this was raised to Congressman Garamendi's staff.
