MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chairman Davis called the meeting of January 21, 2022, Reservoir Committee Meeting to order at the hour of 9:00 a.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL:

Roll of the Reservoir Committee was called (Attachment A), which resulted in 20 eligible representatives. This equated to 91.26% of the current participation being in attendance, which is greater than the 50% needed to have a quorum of the Reservoir Committee.

INTRODUCTIONS:

The Sites Staff, Consultants, and members of the public introduced themselves.

AGENDA APPROVAL:

It was moved by Cheng, seconded by Tincher to approve the January 21, 2022 Agenda of the Reservoir Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

PERIOD FOR PUBLIC COMMENT:

Chairman Davis called for a period of public comment. Hearing none, he closed the period for public comment.

Chairman Davis made time to consider Consent Agenda Item Numbers 1.1 through 1.4.

Ms. Flores stated she was present for Open Session and Ms. Pryor was present for Closed Session and requested that be reflected in the Minutes/record.

Chairman Davis so directed.

ACTION/CONSENT AGENDA:

It was moved by Tincher, seconded by Flores to approve Consent Agenda Item Numbers 1.1 through 1.4 are as follows:

- 1.4 Authorize teleconference meetings, pursuant to Brown Act Provision provided under Assembly Bill 361, effective through February 20, 2022.

Motion carried unanimously.

2. Action Items:

2.1 Approve administrative amendments to the standard consulting contracts with the Executive Director and Authority Agents related to indemnification and limitation of liability. Authorize an adjustment in the monthly compensation amount with Spesert Consulting over the 3-year term of the agreement and add a requirement that additional insurance is carried by Spesert Consulting throughout the term of the contract.

Executive Director Brown provided an update on the administrative amendments to the standard consulting contracts with himself and the Authority Agents related to indemnification and limitation of liability. He also spoke to an adjustment in monthly compensation for Spesert Consulting as well

as an added requirement that additional insurance be carried by Spesert Consulting throughout the term of the contract.

Ms. Traynham stated the Ad hoc Compensation Committee reviewed and recommended to the Reservoir Committee. Discussion followed.

<u>ACTION:</u> It was moved by Traynham, seconded by Azevedo to recommend to the Authority Board to approve administrative amendments to the standard consulting contracts with the Executive Director and Authority Agents related to indemnification and limitation of liability. Further, recommend to the Authority Board to authorize an adjustment in the monthly compensation amount with Spesert Consulting over the 3-year term of the agreement and add a requirement that additional insurance is carried by Spesert Consulting throughout the term of the contract. Motion carried unanimously.

Executive Director Brown provided a brief update on the Amendment 3 Project Agreement Approval Process including estimated participation levels and rebalancing and requested an update from participants.

- Mr. Carter stated (Carter MWC) board would consider this matter in February 2022.
- Mr. Ruiz stated (Westside WD) board would consider this matter in February 2022.
- Ms. Flores stated (Zone 7 WA) approved the current participation of 10,000 AF.
- Mr. Marks stated (Santa Clarita Valley) board will be considering this matter in February 2022 at the current participation level of 5,000 AF.
- Ms. Kao stated she had nothing new to report. Is still being worked on.
- Mr. Azevedo stated (Colusa County) has no changes and would be considered before the Board in March 2022.

- Ms. Dawley stated (GCID) Board would consider this in February 2022
- Ms. Welch stated (IRWD) would consider in February 2022.
- Mr. Neudeck (Metropolitan WD) stated information on Survey is accurate for now.
- Ms. Traynham (LaGrande/Davis WD) stated information on Survey is accurate.
