MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chair Bettner called to order the Reservoir Committee Meeting at the hour of 9:00 a.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL:

Roll of the Reservoir Committee was called (Attachment A) which resulted in 19 eligible representatives. This equated to 90.93% of the current participation percentage being in attendance, which is greater than the 50% needed to have a quorum of the Reservoir Committee.

INTRODUCTIONS:

The Sites Staff, Consultants, and members of the public introduced themselves.

AGENDA APPROVAL:

It was moved by Ms. Traynham, seconded by Mr. Ruiz to approve the August 19, 2022, Reservoir Committee Meeting Agenda. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Counsel Doud announced the Reservoir Committee would consider the following Closed Session matters:

PERIOD FOR PUBLIC COMMENT:

Chair Bettner called for a period for public comment. Hearing none, he closed the period for public comment.

1. **CONSENT AGENDA**:

It was moved by Ms. Pryor, seconded by Ms. Traynham to approve Consent Agenda Item Numbers 1.1 through 1.5 as follows:

- 1.1 Approve the July 22, 2022 Reservoir Committee Meeting Minutes.
- 1.2 Accept the Sites Project Authority Treasurer's Report.
- 1.3 Approve the Payment of Claims.
- 1.4 Accept the Sites Project Authority's Q2 2022 Budget Year Quarterly Financial Report.
- 1.5 Authorize a Task Order Amendment No. 4 to ICF Task Order No. 3 which would increase the total task order amount by \$257,019 bringing the authorized not to exceed 2022 budget amount to \$5,795,823. Further, authorize a transfer of \$257,019 of Planning and Permitting unrestricted contingency funds to offset the increased task order budget amount.

Motion carried unanimously.

2. Action Items:

2.1 Approve the 2021 Financial Auditor's Report.

Mr. Trapasso spoke to the 2021 Financial Auditor's Report and summarized the following:

- Development of several financial policies and procedures.
- River City Bank confirmed all funds are insured by FDIC and through their collateralized pool program.
- Participation liability is 8.8 million.

Mr. Kunde mentioned the proper filings of the audit report.

Ms. Traynham explained that Ms. Vaughn, the Authority's Accountant, completes the audit filings.

ACTION:

It was moved by Mr. Azevedo, seconded by Mr. Ruiz to recommend to the Authority Board to approve the 2021 Financial Auditor's Report. **Motion carried unanimously.**

2.2 Accept the Terminal Regulating Reservoir (TRR) West site for advancing TRR design and authorize amendment of the Amendment 3 work plan and task orders to align with advancing TRR design at the TRR West site.

Mr. Luu gave a presentation on Final TRR Siting and spoke to the following:

- TRR West Considerations and Investigations.
 - Real Estate.
 - Construction Cost.
 - Assumed not to be within Division of Safety of Dams jurisdiction.
- TRR Siting and Recommendations.
 - Acceptance of the TRR West site for advancing TRR design.
 - Removing all planned geotechnical investigation activities required to inform the design of the TRR East site.
 - Redefining all design-related activities for the TRR to focus on the TRR West site.
 - Recommend directing all TRR coordination efforts to reflect the TRR West site.

Ms. Kao inquired about TRR East in the original footprint, as opposed to TRR West.

Chair Bettner noted the Department of Water Resources had originally envisioned TRR East in the original footprint of the project due to reasons like elevation and lower ground that would make it easier to fill, but additional investigations proved TRR West is the logical choice.

ACTION:

It was moved by Mr. Azevedo, seconded by Ms. Pryor to recommend to the Authority Board to accept TRR West site for advancing TRR design and authorize amendment of the Amendment 3 work plan and task orders to align with advancing TRR design at the TRR West site. **Motion carried unanimously.**

3. <u>Discussion and Information Items</u>:

3.1 Receive a status update on the Project's Water Right application.

Ms. Forsythe gave a presentation on the Water Right Update and spoke to the following:

- Submitted application May 11, 2022, awaiting a response from State Board on acceptance and noticing or needing additional information.
- Water Right Schedule
 - Aug 2022 Board deems application complete and releases public notice of protest period (at least 60 days).
 - Oct 2022 deadline to submit protests.
 - Nov 2022 through April 2023 minimum 180-day protest resolution period.
 - May 2023 through February 2024 hearing preparation, conduct hearing, final decision and written permit issued.

Brief discussion followed.

3.2 Receive an update on the development of the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR)/Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Ms. Forsythe gave a presentation on the Final EIR/EIS update and spoke to the following:

- Roles of Authority Board and Reservoir Committee.
 - Authority Board lead Agency under California Environmental Quality Act takes first CEQA action, members decide in the context of the Authority's decision (not their own agency's decision).
 - Each Reservoir ommittee Member is a responsible Agency under CEQA, follow on CEQA action prior to the final decision to invest in Project, important that each member's Agency can make this decision based on the Authority's Final EIR/EIS.
- Final EIR/EIS Development, Final EIR/EIS Format, Changes between RDEIR/SDEIS, and Final EIR/EIS to date.
- CEQA Decision Process (In Order)
 - 1. Certification of the Final EIR completed in compliance with CEQA and reflects agency's independent judgment.
 - 2. Adopt CEQA Findings and Statement of Overriding Considerations.
 - 3. Decide whether to approve the Project.
- Completion of Administrative Final EIR/EIS in October and concurrent review by Reclamation, legal counsel, and responsible and cooperating agencies.
- Preparation of the complete Final EIR/EIS in early 2023.

Mr. Azevedo spoke to the plan to call out the changes in the Final EIR/EIS Chapters.

Mr. Kunde spoke to the CEQA Decision Process.

Chair Bettner spoke to the project's CEQA Documents in relation to CDFW input.

Brief discussion followed.
