CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chair Durst called the Sites Project Authority Board (AB) Meeting to order at the hour of 1:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

INTRODUCTIONS:

Chair Durst asked those present to introduce themselves.

AGENDA APPROVAL:

It was moved by Director Sutton, seconded by Director Allen to approve the October 26, 2022, Authority Board Agenda. Motion carried: All Directors present voted yes.

PERIOD FOR PUBLIC COMMENT:

Chair Durst called for a period for public comment. Hearing none, he closed the period for public comment.
