

This action item summary is being provided to inform the Boards of the follow-up that has been taken to the requests during November’s Reservoir Committee and Authority Board meetings.

Action Item	Status
<p>Jerry to speak further with DWR and report back on when water can be moved through the delta.</p>	<p>To date, operating plans have evaluated movement of Sites water to PWAs through delta during the transfer window as non-project water. This question is understood to be requesting a more nuanced evaluation depending on the location of diversion in delta. DWR has indicated a willingness to discuss this nuance in conjunction with the 3 party Operations Agreement.</p>
<p>Review and adjust the communication budget to the original amount and exclude the extra outreach efforts. Future Leg & Outreach to review the scope and timing of extra outreach efforts and incorporate them into the budget.</p>	<p>The comms budget line item has been adjusted to exclude extra outreach efforts at this time. Plan a January 2023 Leg & Outreach Committee meeting to consider potentially new scope, budget, and timing of additional outreach activities and incorporate them into the Communications service provider’s 2023 work plan. This will be brought to the full Board to make any needed adjustments to the comms budget line item following the Committee meeting.</p>
<p>We reviewed prior action items that were outstanding and below is the updated status.</p>	
<p>May 2022 - Create “one-pager” to communicate the significant environmental “net” benefit improvement in the project since 2017. Also incorporate how having Sites in 2022 could help with salmon survival this year.</p>	<p>This is an involved effort because of the various models being used to evaluate effects. We expect to have preliminary results from the UC Santa Cruz work before this product is finalized.</p> <p>This effort is behind schedule and is expected to be completed end of December.</p>
