The Final Guiding Principles....

Adopted November 2022

- ✓ Guide the **basic mechanics** for allocating benefits and costs, collecting payments, and remedying defaults prior to advancing further into WIFIA Loan application process
- Serve as the foundation for drafting the Sites Reservoir Benefits and Obligations Contract and will inform development of similar contracts for State and Federal participation

The Benefits and Obligations Contract

- Will serve as the long-term commitment of the Sites
 Authority to provide the Participant with its capacity rights in
 the Sites Reservoir system
- Represents what each Participant will need to take to its respective home board to secure the necessary authority to commit to its capacity share in the Sites Project

Proposed Contract drafting approach

- Same Contract for all Participants (with differences defined in payment annexes)
- Reference policies/technical information that can be updated without revisiting the Contract. Contract development is concurrent with development of other agreements and policies.
- Existing approved documents will be the foundation for the Contract
- Amendment 3 participation levels assumed (pending 'tentative' changes identified in mid-2023 soft call)
