Five Tribes with Traditional or Cultural Affiliation with the Project Area

- Nomlaki descendants:
 - Grindstone Indian Rancheria of Wintun-Wailaki Indians
 - Paskenta Band of Nomlaki Indians (Nomlāqa Bōda)
- Patwin descendants:
 - Cachil Dehe Band of Wintun (Colusa Indian Community)
 - Kletsel Dehe Wintun Nation (Cortina Indian Rancheria)
 - Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation (Rumsey Indian Rancheria)



Existing and Proposed Contracted Efforts

- Existing Contracted Efforts
 - Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation
 - Currently conducting geotechnical monitoring
- Proposed Contracts
 - Cachil Dehe Band of Wintun → \$120,000
 - Geotechnical monitoring
 - Previously conducted geotechnical monitoring
 - Existing contract, slight modification to reinitiate efforts
 - FY 23 and FY 24 efforts
 - Paskenta Band of Nomlaki Indians → \$250,000
 - Geotechnical monitoring, primarily for areas in Glenn County
 - Ethnographic study for Paskenta and Grindstone
 - FY 23 and FY 24 efforts
