

Sites Reservoir Mitigation Providers and Construction Contractors Interactive Workshop

The Sites Project Authority continues to make progress towards building a more resilient and flexible water future for California. The Authority plans to begin construction of the new offstream 1.5-million-acre-foot, Sites Reservoir in 2026 and begin operations as early as 2031. In addition to ongoing planning and engineering, current activities include development of a compensatory terrestrial biological mitigation strategy to meet Project requirements in advance of effects that could result from Project construction and operations. Coordination between the Authority's engineering and mitigation planning teams is integral to the success of achieving the Project schedule.

The Authority will be conducting a workshop to *provide updated Project information to mitigation providers* and *solicit input and feedback from mitigation providers* to inform continued development of a strategy to meet the Project's mostly terrestrial biological compensatory mitigation requirements for both construction and operation. The overall goal of the Authority for its terrestrial biological compensatory mitigation is to meet all regulatory requirements while also meeting the Project's schedule and budget, in a way that seeks to deliver additional benefits to the local and regional biological and human communities. A Project update will also be provided for interested construction contractors.

Please join us for this presentation and interactive discussion that will be hosted by the Authority. The Authority's Agents will present an update of the Project's status and share information on development of the Authority's mitigation strategy, including packaging, contracting, and scheduling. This is an opportunity for all providers and contractors to receive updated Project information, and for mitigation providers to give early input and feedback on the Authority's strategy for terrestrial biological compensatory mitigation.
