3. Manager's Report:

3.1 Discussion and possible direction to staff regarding the General Manager's monthly status report. (Attachment 3-1A)

General Manager Watson provided an update for the month of February 2019 regarding the finalized Phase 2 2019 Participation Agreement, issued notice to proceed on four contracts, invoicing for Phase 2 participants, continued coordination with Reclamation, continued outreach activities and assembling a panel for interview of a Planning and Permitting Manager. He also provided an overview of matters approved and/or discussed at the February 25, 2019 Authority Board Meeting.

General Manager Watson also stated a posting for summer interns has been placed on the website for any college or high school students interested in a summer job.

Mr. Buttz and Mr. Robinette also provided an update on ongoing activities related to Service Areas A and B, respectively.

Mr. Spesert provided an overview and review of the Washington, DC trip, March 13 – 15, 2019. Discussion followed with no action taken.

General Manager Watson reminds Committee Members who participated in 2018 that FPPC Form 700 forms are due by April 1, 2019.

3.2 Discussion and possible direction to staff regarding Proposition 1 WSIP application activities.

General Manager Watson provided an overview of a meeting held by the California Water Commission. Discussion followed regarding two letters sent to the Commission; one from several non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and the other from the Karuk Tribe regarding effects to the Trinity River by the Sites Project with no action taken. Additional discussion occurred regarding the Water Commission's adoption of Resolution 2019-02 regarding eligibility of additional funds for Sites Project with no action taken.

3.3 Discussion and possible direction to staff on ongoing U.S. Bureau of Reclamation activities and WIIN Act Funding.

General Manager Watson provided an update on the ongoing coordination activities with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and efforts to secure WIIN Act funding, i.e. final EIS and the Feasibility Report. Brief discussion followed with no action taken.

3.4 Discussion and possible direction to staff regarding the withdrawal of Pacific Resources from the Sites Reservoir Committee for Phase 2 (2019) (Attachments 3-4A)

General Manager Watson informed the Reservoir Members of the intent of Pacific Resources to withdraw from the Sites Reservoir Committee in advance of Phase 2 (2019), effective March 31, 2019. Discussion followed regarding reimbursement of the Phase 1 investment in the amount of \$485,000.00 and their request to be able to apply their contributed credit should they wish to re-join the project at a future date, with no action taken.
