# October 26, 2022 Sites Project Authority – Minutes

# CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Chair Durst called the Sites Project Authority Board (AB) Meeting to order at the hour of 1:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
