Sites Reservoir Project

1.0 GENERAL

The Sites Project Authority (Sites Authority) is currently seeking bids from experienced and qualified barbed wire fence installers.

2.0 DESCRIPTION OF THE SITES PROJECT AUTHORITY

The Sites Authority is a joint exercise of powers authority formed on August 26, 2010, pursuant to California Government Code Section 6500 et seq. The Sites Authority is governed by a 9-voting member Board of Directors, including several local water agencies and Colusa and Glenn counties. The Sites Authority receives advisory support from 22 local water agencies located statewide (the Reservoir Committee) who have entered into Project agreements to help fund and advance the Sites Reservoir Project (Project). 3.0 DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The Sites Authority is soliciting bids from **C-13 Fencing Contractor licensed** contractors for the installation of approximately 14,000 linear feet of 5 strand barbed wire fence. The location of the fence is on recently acquired property by the Sites Authority approximately 7 miles west of the Town of Maxwell and will run from the Sites Lodoga Road north to an approximate area adjacent to Funks Reservoir. This is a public works contract subject to Department of Industrial Relations registration and payment of prevailing wage.

4.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Department of Industrial Relations Registration: All contractors and subcontractors shall register with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to California Labor Code sections 1771.1 and 1725.5 prior to bidding on the Project. The Authority will not consider bids from bidders who have not registered in compliance with the law.

Prevailing Wage: This Project is subject to prevailing wage rates. Copies of the prevailing rates or per diem wages applicable to this Project are available from the California Department of Labor Statistics and Research at www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/PWD/index.htm or 455 Golden Gate Avenue, 9th Floor, San Francisco, California 94102 (415) 703-4780. Contractors will be required to post a copy of the wage rates on the job site. Any employee whose type of work is not covered by any of the classified wage rates shall be paid not less than the rate of wage listed for the classification which most nearly corresponds to the type of work to be performed. Pursuant to California Labor Code section 1775, the Contractor, and any subcontractor, shall forfeit up to \$200.00 per calendar day, or portion of a day, for each worker paid less than the prevailing rates for such work or craft, and the penalty shall be imposed and distributed pursuant to Section 1775.

Payroll Records: A contractor and any subcontractors will be required to keep accurate payroll records pursuant to California Labor Code section 1776(a). The records shall be furnished at least once a month to the California Labor Commission pursuant to California Labor Code section 1771.4(a)(3).

Description of Request: Furnish all materials, labor and equipment for a barbed wire fence and accessories, located approximately 7 miles west of the Town of Maxwell as more specifically detailed on the Project Specifications below.

Types of Bids Required:

A. Unit-price bids shall be provided, per the specification sheet included with this request for bids. Award will be made on the lowest total bid for all items and quantities listed.

B. Conditional Bids shall not be considered

Time of Completion: The work is to be completed within ninety (90) calendar days measured from the date of full execution of the Authority Contract.

Time and Place of Submission of Bids:

A. Time: Bids shall be electronically submitted through PlanetBids on or before May 19, 2025 no later than 2:00 p.m.

B. Place: All Bids shall be submitted through [PlanetBids](#):

C. No hand delivered, oral, telephonic, faxed, or e-mailed proposals or modifications will be considered.

D. A responsive bid must include the fully completed Bid Worksheet in PlanetBids.

E. Any questions regarding this RFB can be submitted to the [PlanetBids](#) website until 2:00 p.m. May 14, 2025:

Any addenda issued shall be included in the bid proposal.

F. Bid pricing shall remain open and valid subject to acceptance for ninety (90) days after RFB closing date.

G. Bids may be withdrawn after bid opening only by providing written notice to Sites Authority within five (5) working days of the bid opening and the notice is in compliance with Public Contract Code section 5100 *et seq.*, or as otherwise may be allowed with the consent of Sites Authority.

H. Upon submission of Bid, all such documents shall become the property of the Sites Authority.

I. All bid pricing shall be based on meeting all contract requirements in the draft contract included with the bid package.

I. The Authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

J. The successful vendor shall be required to enter into a contract with the Authority for the services to be provided. Such contract shall incorporate the specifications of the RFB and the bid prices proposed. (A draft copy is attached)

Guarantees: The successful vendor shall guarantee all services provided and shall require each Subcontractor, as applicable, to guarantee their own work, against defective material or faulty workmanship for a minimum of one year after the date of Notice of Completion is issued. In addition, all standard manufacturer warranties shall be passed to the Authority which may extend the warranty period beyond one year. Refer to paragraph 2.15 in the attached contract.

Quantity and Quality of Materials or Services: All materials and supplies furnished for this Project must comply with contract plans and specifications. Materials, supplies, and/or installations which do not meet the requirements set forth in the plans and specifications, shall be rejected by the Authority. The vendor shall promptly remove such deficient work from the Authority's premises and remediate the work to comply with the requirements of

the plans and specifications at the vendors expense.

Award: The Project shall be awarded to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder in accordance with California Public Contract Code section 20128.

Each Bid shall follow the format specified by the Authority. Any bid not complying with the Authority format shall be considered nonresponsive.

Securing Document: The bid specifications are obtainable from [PlanetBids](#).

Withdrawing Bids: No Vendor may withdraw their bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date and time set for the opening thereof, after confirming the technical and formal sufficiency of the Bid of the three (3) lowest vendors. In no event shall the Bid of the three (3) lowest vendors be released before execution with the Authority of an Agreement with the successful vendor, or the expiration of ninety (90) days, whichever occurs first.

Rejection of Bids: The Authority reserves all rights to utilize any alternate procedure authorized by the Public Contract Code Sections 20150.9 and 20150.10, including but not limited to rejecting all bids and/or to waive any informality in the RFB process.

Default by Vendor: In case of default by vendor, the Authority reserves the right to:

- A. Cancel the order and obtain the service on the open market, in which case, Vendor shall be responsible to Authority for the difference between the Bid price and the purchase price if the purchase is higher; and/or
- B. Assess a reasonable per day charge against the vendor for inconvenience or damages incurred by Authority as a result of delayed delivery, except when delivery is delayed by fire, strike, freight embargo, act of Government, or an act of God.
- C. The rights and remedies of the Authority provided above shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or under the contract.

Non-Funding Clause: Funds provided for commodities or services under the terms of an agreement, contract or Bid are contingent on availability of funds. Should sufficient funds not be allocated during those terms, amounts due may be modified or terminated at any time by the Authority upon thirty (30) day notice. Notice shall be fully given in writing or through service in person or by first class mail.

Detailed specifications are attached, marked "Project Specifications". These minimum specifications are not intended to be restrictive, but descriptive of the type and quality of

product the Authority desires to obtain. Vendors will not be allowed to make unauthorized substitutions.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The respondent is to conduct all services performed on behalf of the Sites Authority in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of the State of California.
