Subject: Conditions Precedent Reporting

#### **Requested Action:**

Receive and comment on the updated conditions precedent quarterly status report.

#### **Detailed Description/Background:**

For the past 15 months, the Conditions Precedent Report has been presented to the Board on a quarterly basis as a status update on the critical items the Board has identified as necessary for their agency's execution of the Benefits & Obligations Contract. Also presented was a Storage Partner Approvals Coordination Table to represent the permits and approvals needed across all of the Storage Partners; Participants/Reservoir Committee members, State/California Water Commission, and Federal/Bureau of Reclamation. Having a common list of expected deliverables ensures Sites Staff, consultants, and all Storage Partners prioritize efforts in the right places. These logic connections are incorporated into the Amendment 3 schedule update, Agenda Item 4.4C.

This report updates on the progress of items listed in Attachment A since the April 2025 report. Board members, state representatives and federal representatives are requested to confirm any changes or additions to their needs for executing contracts during investor commitment escrow.

As expected, schedules for some items in the report have shifted, but critical items are progressing and are being completed. The key activity to starting investor commitment is issuance of the water right order. The closing reply briefs were submitted on June 27, 2025, so the water right hearing process is now fully in the Administrative Hearings Office and the State Water Resources Control Board's court. As mentioned in the April report, there is still some uncertainty in the actual timing of the water right decision. The current working assumption in the schedule is that the order will be issued sometime in Q4 of 2025. The Authority anticipates a 2-month process to true-up documents to the final water right order. Therefore, Participants should plan to be in the six-month investor escrow, starting as early as December 1, 2025, or as late as April 1, 2026. If the later date for the water right holds, Participants should consider taking steps early to assist in compressing the

escrow period to shorter than six months to align with funding availability, unless other sources of funds are identified.

During the last quarter, two items have been identified as coming in after the start of investor commitment. They are the Operations Biological Opinion (BiOps) and the 404/401 permits. The current scheduling assumption for each is that:

- The investor commitment period may begin before completing the Operations BiOps from the Participants' perspective, but completing the Operations BiOps remains necessary for the State and Federal Partners to execute their contracts.
- The 404/401 permits are only a condition precedent for the State and the current schedule shows these permits completing before the end of investor commitment. This should be acceptable because the State requires all other Storage Partners to be committed before they will make their final award and the permits are scheduled to be complete by this time.
